

# Making a Walkie-Talkie Call

## What You'll Need








To use Direct Connect® walkie-talkie service, both you and the person you're calling must:

- Have Direct Connect® walkie-talkie-capable phones<sup>1</sup>
- Be located within the same Direct Connect® calling area
- Have rate plans provisioned with Direct Connect® walkie-talkie minutes

To use Nationwide Direct Connect<sup>SM</sup> and International Direct Connect<sup>SM</sup> walkie-talkie service, you need your contact's full Direct Connect® walkie-talkie number (Area ID\*Network ID\*Member ID). Plus, both you and the person you're calling must:

- Have phones<sup>2</sup> that support these services
- Have rate plans provisioned with Direct Connect® walkie-talkie minutes







## Find Your Direct Connect® Walkie-Talkie Number

Press    . (For i2000 and i2000plus phones, press ,  under **Prgm** and then .)

You will see a set of three numbers, separated by a \*. This entire number (including the asterisks) represents your Direct Connect® walkie-talkie number--for example, 111\*222\*3333. The first set of numbers is your **Area ID**, the second set is your **Network ID** and the last set is your **Member ID**.

Be sure to exchange the full Direct Connect® walkie-talkie number (Area ID\*Network ID\*Member ID) with other Nextel customers so you can contact each other using Direct Connect®, Nationwide Direct Connect<sup>SM</sup> and International Direct Connect<sup>SM</sup> walkie-talkie services.

## Make a Walkie-Talkie Call



1. Press  until **Prvt Ready** appears.
2. Enter the **Area ID** number and press   (or scroll through your list to locate the name/number and skip to step 5).
3. Enter the **Network ID** number and press  .
4. Enter the **Member ID** number.
5. Press and hold the **Direct Connect® walkie-talkie button** while you talk, or press  under **Alert** and then press the button.

## Answer a Walkie-Talkie Call












To answer a call, simply press and hold the Direct Connect® walkie-talkie button to talk. Release the button to listen.

## Store a Number

(This Quickstore feature is not available on all phones.)

1. With the Direct Connect® walkie-talkie number on your screen, press  under **Store**.
2. Enter the name associated with the number and press  under **Store**.

## Edit a Stored Number


1. Press     .
2. At the **Prvt ID List Edit** screen, press  under "Ok."
3. At the **Edit Entry?** screen, press  under "OK"
4. Press  to scroll to the entry you want to edit.
5. Press  under "OK"
6. Enter the new Private ID number and press  under "Store."
7. Press  under "Exit" until you see the **Phone Ready** screen.

## Use VibraCall®

(The VibraCall® feature is not available on all phones.)

To be silently notified of incoming Direct Connect® walkie-talkie calls:




i2000 and i2000plus phones:

1. Press  until you see the **Prgm** option.
2. Select **Prgm**.
3. Press the number **9** key.
4. Select **All**.

i1000, i1000plus and i700plus phones:

1. Press    and the number **9** key.
2. Select **All**.

i600 phones:

1. Press    and the number **9** key.
2. Select **OK**.
3. Select **Exit** twice.
